Emergency Carer ID Card

Carers NZ's Emergency Carer ID Card is designed for those who provide regular or 24 hour support for an elderly, ill, or disabled family member or friend.

- Print the Card and cut along trim marks.
- Complete the information, then fold the Card in half and laminate it for your wallet or key ring.
- If you become ill or die suddenly, others will be able to step in quickly to help the person you support.
- Update this card if any details change.
- Complete our full set of emergency Care Planning Tools, which include an Emergency Care Plan, Medications Plan, and Important Papers Checklist; give copies to others so they know what to do if you are incapacitated.
